TH-S discussed re Mt Lagoon and Willow Vale being on a week apart but less than 300kms. Willowvale had not booked an 80km ride and that it was a mini marathon, which should not cause problems.

Amanda Apperley told the meeting she is going to amend her ride application form to include an 80k ride. She further advised it makes no difference to her if she runs at a loss.

CF advised that right now the SMC can only deal with the rides before them and the applications currently received.

Amanda Apperley reiterated that she will be putting in a request to amend her ride by putting in for an 80k event-

It was pointed out that by doing that, the date of her ride may affect Mt Lagoon. The SMC would like to support Zone One getting up and running again. They should be provided an opportunity to have a successful ride. When they picked their ride date they knew there would be no 80k event in the week before or after their ride. That's why they chose the date.

At this time, Linda Jonkers asked what support had been offered to the South Coast Zone.

The rides seeking approval are a mini Marathon for Willowvale and an 80 plus event for Mt Lagoon. Mt Lagoon did the right thing when it put in its ride application form.

CF advised Amanda Apperley that this was discussions for the SMC. Asking her to please wait until general business.

**Woodstock** - [traditionally the second weekend in September – RCC had reserved 14/15<sup>th</sup> September for this endurance event]. ROC has requested 7 & 8<sup>th</sup> September.

RCC spoke to ROC and said it was already taken by the Johns River Committee [affiliated with NSWERA and QERA; and on the 2024 calendar]. Johns River held its ride on the first weekend of September 2023. The 7 & 8<sup>th</sup> is the first full weekend in September in 2024.

# Lengthy discussion on the Woodstock ride date and Johns River.

By way of explanation, Linda Jonkers spoke at this meeting to discuss the issue that the Woodstock and Johns River ride have booked on the same weekend.

Discussion as to how this could be managed so that both rides were not compromised.

While Johns River had provided their Ride Booking form first. Woodstock considered that their ride's traditional weekend was the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in September.

CF advised that the Woodstock ROC did not discuss this ride application with her. The form was sent in with no discussion. Had they checked they would have seen that NSW ERA have affiliated and dual affiliated and approved the Johns River ride on 7 and 8 September. This ride has been moved numerous times to accommodate other ROS. Restricted weekends when the grounds can be used so not totally flexible on their dates.

CF suggested that NSW ERA stick to its already agreed dates for Johns Rider. Do not affiliate Woodstock on the same weekend. Putting a ride on the same weekend is not going to be beneficial to that ride.

AC discussed that Woodstock is 588 kms away from Johns Rider. Why not approve both dates?

Discussing the traditional ride date for Woodstock.

Linda Jonkers said their traditional date is the second Sunday in September. Been on that date for 32 years. What happens to supporting a club that runs many teaching weekends, put on the State Champs four times? Asked to run again. Linda's ride is almost 600k away from John's River.

Lengthy discussion on the reasons for not affiliating the Woodstock ride. Suggestion that Peter Kelly is the president for Zone 6 and he should be here to discuss the dates.

Linda Jonkers was under the impression that traditional ride dates still applied. This no longer appears to be the case. If she moved her ride date to later in September, it would clash with Central Ranges and she is not willing to do this.

March 16 and 17 is now available. Linda Jonkers advised this date did not suit her ride club. Busy organising Bumbaldry. LJ will email her club and put the matter over to them.

Suggested that all parties must agree if a ride is to be held on the same date.

Linda Henley declared a conflict of interest as she is the ride secretary for Johns River.

**Resolved** that the Zone 6 President, Peter Kelly and President of LERC, Linda Jonkers needed to both attend a meeting in order to find a compromise to this issue.

### 213. Endurance Chatter post by Amanda Apperley

The Chair advised the meeting that she had just been advised by a member by text message that Amanda Apperley had just posted details on a public Facebook site of what was being discussed at the meeting whilst she in attendance and criticising the SMC in public on social media.

Discussion held whilst Amanda Apperley was still at the meeting re this post.

General discussion on Amanda Apperley's post to Endurance Chatter. The comments posted by her were incorrect. Not appropriate that a posting be made during a meeting. Totally inappropriate that this has gone up in the middle of a meeting. Violated the Code of Conduct and social media policies. Suggestion that she should receive a formal letter stating violation of AERA Social Media rules and should not be allowed to attend any further meetings.

Discussion as to whether the SMC can stop people attending because they criticise the SMC. Could be considered overreacting.

General consensus was that this was a violation of the Code of Conduct and Social Media Rules.

Amanda Apperley noted that she knew the meeting is recorded. Trying to prove the SMC doesn't follow the constitution. She advised the meeting that the SMC "don't follow the Constitution": " were a bunch of self egotistic people". "Need the NSW members to know who is running the sport". "For you to get the facts straight. You're all a disgrace". Amanda Apperley then left the meeting.

#### 214. Clare Fleming: Logbooks.

There is a current rule regarding not defiling logbooks. Ruling lines across the logbooks with Vet out. Not really necessary. Still happening. Any horse that did not elevate on the last weekend ride had the same ruled lines written across the page with DNE. Should not have been put there. Not the correct practice. What should have been written was "Completion 120 and DNE". No need to draw the lines across log books. Would like something to go the ROCs who are dealing with the log books that this should not be done.

**Resolved** Sarah will send out an email to the vets advising them of the rules relating to what goes into the logbooks.

# 215. Electronic timing by Tom McCormack - Belinda Hopley addressed the meeting

If Tom does the ET system, Tom is not to be a Chief Steward at that particular ride. ROs are slow to embrace their knowledge of the ETS. Were hoping for one in north, one in the south and one in the west.

**Resolved** to put up a post on Endurance NSW Facebook asking for expressions of interest for people to be responsible for the ETS. This has been put online in the past with a list of the requirements and rewards. Nothing has eventuated from this. Need to get this out there again.

**Resolved** BH will update the appropriate document and send on to LH for posting. WH-asked what computer knowledge is required of a person to take on this role. This needs to be stipulated as well.

#### 216. Discussion on Equestrian Australia -

Discussion - incentive to stimulate people to become Swabbing Stewards. Possibly cover costs for training and costs of membership. They would not be expected to do it at every single ride. Problem is lack of training opportunities.

Sport pays EA over \$8,000 for affiliation fees and they won't run any swabbing clinics. Possibly 2024 or 2025 at the earliest. Not getting anything back from EA for our money.

Wrap up of Discussion - need to work together and utilise information. No need to reinvent the wheel. Great group of people working really hard for the sport. Hopefully we can get members more involved in some of these tasks.

# PRESIDENT'S REPORT 8 November 2023

The State Championships at Wandandian was a very successful weekend. Congratulations to the ride organisers. The ride base looked sensational decked out with banners and floral decoration and the effort to gain sponsors and prizes provided a great standard for the State. The administration and vetting area were streamline, with an enormous amount of experience being on hand. The marking was sensational and there was no opportunity for anyone to get lost! If there was a downside it was the number of motorbikes on the course. The ride organisers had given warning that the event was being run which was not heeded by many recreational bikers. Requesting closure of the Forestry and National Parks to bike riders is an expensive option but may need to be addressed in the future to ensure safety of horses and riders. The course was very challenging, made even more so by heavy rain creating slippery conditions. However, having cool, wet weather was definitely in preference to heat and humidity. The completion rate in both rides was a credit to the riders respecting the course.

Sarah Parker riding Cooroora Allyjah in a time of 12:28 is our new State Champion. Three riders took the option to withdraw at 120kms which allowed for riders to complete part of the course and use discretion to not continue and still gain "mileage" for their horse and rider history. The 80km ride was a testing course over the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Legs of the 160km course and was won in a time of 7:54 by Jill Kalkman riding Miss Muppet. Again, the experience of those riding was evident in the completion rate.

I hope the last few meetings of this present SMC can be given over to developing plans to provide financial assistance to both ride organisers and riders. Congratulations to the small but committed Willow Vale ROC for hosting the 2023 NSW State Championships with lots of wonderful sponsorship, prizes and entertainment, as well as a challenging course for the riders in both events. Six SMC members successfully competed at the event, four in the 120-160km, and two in the 80km event. We are now calling for EOI for the 2024 State Champs and interested parties should contact our RCC, Clare Fleming, for more information.

Pony Club Australia has requested using some junior imagery for their next online promotion of Endurance nationally as "inspiration" to their Pony Club members. We've supplied "something for everyone/starting out" content previously so we will now feature our two successful juniors in the 160km State Champs event as inspiration for Pony Club riders who may be competitive.

# Membership Analysis 2023

Analysis of the membership stats from 2023 has shown some interesting results. Whilst the overall membership is static with the last 2 years, the growth areas show positive signs. Ride entries also increased very slightly from 2022 (1848) but are still a long way off pre-covid entries (approx 2500) and this result is common in every State. Also worth noting is that none of our Intro Clinic entries (approx 100 for 2023) are included in the AERA figures as these events do not have rider/horse data entered into AERAspace.

We attracted 70 new members in 2023 (20 more than 2022) and 80% of those are under 50 years of age. 38 of those were new Senior Members. 31% were new Junior members which is terrific. We more than doubled our Intermediate Memberships over the previous year however there are still too many Day Memberships sold. Converting those into Intermediate memberships and then stepping up our 40km riders to 80km events is the next challenge.

Having the AGM mid to late February creates issues with memberships already being sold for two months prior to the AGM/change-over of SMC. In March it's too late to start membership drives/promotions as most club memberships kick off on the 1st of January each year so we missed being able to do a membership drive in 2023 due to the peak take-up season being before we were elected. For 2024 we are working on some membership promotions prior to the new year to coincide with the launch of the online AERAonline membership launch which is planned for 1st January.

#### 2024 New Member & ROC Collateral

The new Introduction to Endurance flyer which was promoted online with a QR Code to link to our website created 70 visitors linking to the Flyer on the Get Started web page and 52 downloads of the flyer in a couple of days. 43 of the downloads were new visitors to our site.

The Maxxis brochure "Starting out in Endurance" which is basically an extended version (28pp) of the above has now run out of copies and will be updated to be released in time for our Calendar of smaller events, mini and micro marathon events. This will also be available to download and possibly printed as well.

The ROC Operating Manual will also be updated shortly to include the online Noms etc, and we are working on Logbook applications and Horse Rego/Transfers all being updated to include the new Registrar email and Endurance NSW branding. All documents with the old Registrar email will need to be updated. Membership forms will be removed from the website before AERAonline launch.

#### **Social Endurance Trail Mentors**

After a fabulous first social/intro clinic/ride the H&H Z1 Community will hold their first affiliated Intro Ride on 25th November at Scheyville National Park. We've supplied the last of the Starting Out Brochures to them. The SMC appreciate the efforts of all our Mentors to introduce new members to endurance and we are happy to offer support to these groups anyway we can.

#### Website/Facebook Stats

Our socials are growing well. Our NSWERA Facebook group has grown to 2.9K followers and the website is still attracting a good share of new visitors - 60% of site visits in the month of October were from new visitors. The human interest posts - rider posts after each event and the articles supplied (Little Miss Lani) are achieving the highest reach - averaging 2-3k per post, though the NSWERA bumper slogan post also rated well.

#### **ROC Breakfast after AGM - Sunday 4th Feb**

We are planning on holding a breakfast meeting on the Sunday 4/2/24 for representatives of ROCs/Mentors. More details will be sent in the next ROC Ramble.
